

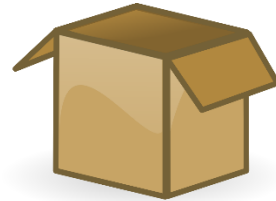
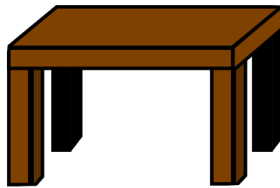
## Maths: Positional Language

### You will need:

A toy (e.g. cuddly toy, dinosaur, car)

A table

A box



Give your child a variety of instructions to follow for where to place the toy.

- Put the toy **on** the table.
- Put the toy **under** the table.
- Put the toy **beside** the table.
- Put the toy **inside** the box.
- Put the toy **between** the table and the box.
- Put the toy **behind** the box.
- Put the toy **in front of** the box.
- Put the toy **next to** the table.

Repeat with different toys until you feel they are confident.

You can also try swapping so that you place the toy and your child has to describe where you have put it using some positional language.

Encourage them to speak in full sentences.
